DIRECTIONS

Community Center of St. Bart's Church 109 East 50th Street

Knock on the door at 109 East 50th and the guard will let you in. Tell the guard you are going to Scottish dancing and they will direct you to the correct floor.

Subway

Number 6 train to 51st Street stop, walk south on Lexington and west on East 50th Street. The entrance is on the north side of East 50th Street.

E or M train to Lexington Avenue-53rd Street stop, walk south on Lexington and west on East 50th Street. The entrance is on the north side of East 50th Street.

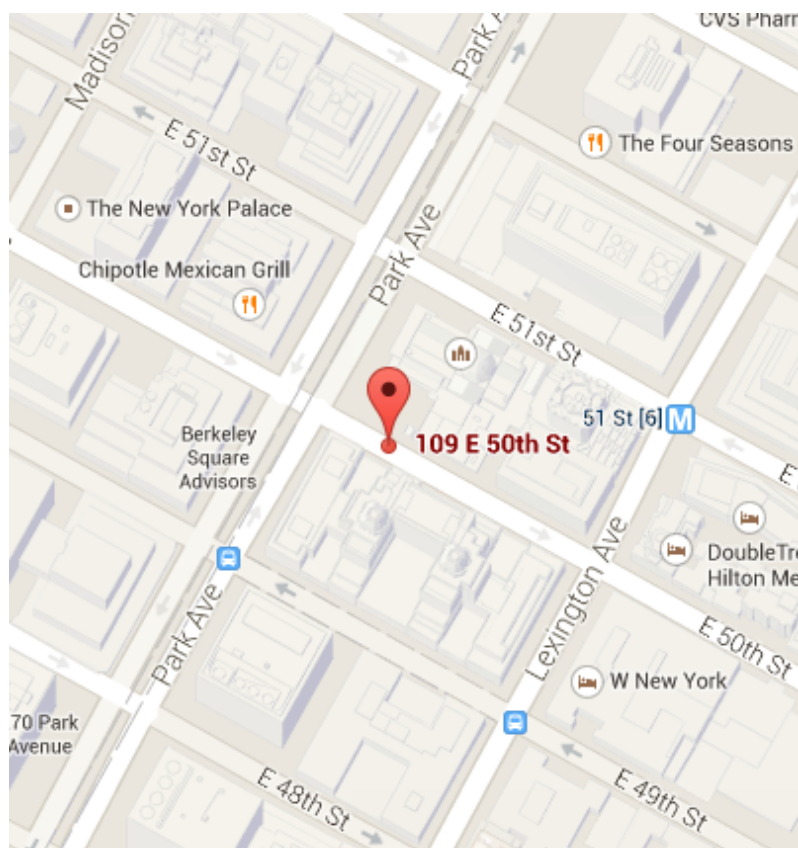
Bus

Lexington Avenue or Third Avenue buses to 50th Street. Walk west on East 50th Street. The entrance is on the north side of East 50th Street.

49/50th Street crosstown bus to Madison Avenue or Lexington Avenue. Only the westbound bus on 49th Street stops at Park Avenue. Walk north (if necessary) to 50th Street. The entrance is on the north side of East 50th Street between Lexington and Park.

Metro North

All lines to Grand Central. Take up escalator from main concourse, walk through the Met Life building to 46th Street, continue on covered walkway through Helmsely building and north on Park Avenue to 50th Street. Turn right on East 50th Street. The entrance is on the north side of East 50th Street.
